Background of the Organization-Assam Building and Other Construction Workers Welfare Board has been established across India under an Act of Parliament of 1996. Subsequently, for the state of Assam the rules were framed in 2007. The primary objective is to register the construction workers and disburse various benefits as mandated under the Act including pensions after the registered workers attain the age of 60. The Board's Fund comprises of the cess collection from various employees under BOCW Cess Act, 1996 and BOCW Cess Act, 1998. Employees Contribution and the Interest accrued. For details, Bidders may refer the following documents-

Terms and Conditions for Internal Audit Service

This document represents the responsibilities and obligations of the stakeholders, the scope of work, conditions of the services covered as mutually understood and agreed by the stakeholders have been outlined. The document also encompasses payment terms and penalties in case of non-adherence to the defined terms and conditions.

1.a. Buyer: The buyer is responsible to provide clear instructions, approvals, and timely payments for the services availed.

1.b. Service Provider: The service provider is responsible to provide all the required services in a timely manner.

2. Audit Service Scope

2.1 Financial Audit - Objective examination and evaluation of the financial statements of an organization to make sure that the financial records are a fair and accurate representation of the transactions they claim to represent.

2.2 Audit report – prepare a financial audit report for the buyer as per the audit conducted
Provision to upload additional scope of work defining the course details, additional requirements will be provided to buyer.

2.3 Internal Audit - The objectives of internal audit of Board, expressing an opinion on the financial statements.

3. Standard Terms & Conditions for the service

3.1. The persons deployed shall, during the course of their work, will have access to classified documents, which they are not supposed to divulge to third parties. Any breach of this condition shall make the service provider liable for penal action under the applicable laws besides action for breach of contract.

3.2. All the document receipts during the course of the audit should be returned after completion of the audit and it shall be Service Provider's responsibility to ensure that all documents and information will be used exclusively for internal audit purposes and should be kept confidential and not to be disclosed to the third party at any point of time.

3.3. The audit personnel for the audit period should not be changed so that continuity and consistency is maintained. The Service Provider shall conduct appropriate due diligence before employing any person who will be entrusted with the work of conducting the audit. The Service Provider is also responsible for any commission and omission of its employees which may cause and or likely to cause any loss/ damage to the Buyer.

3.5. The auditors will also be asked to give a presentation on finding in the Audit Reports to the Finance Committee/Board/relevant forums of the Buyer.

4. Payment Terms

i. The Payment Procedure shall be as specified in the General Terms and Conditions of GeM and the Payment Schedule will be as defined by the Buyer.

9. Evaluation Methodology

- Evaluation of Technical Bid shall be done for determination of eligibility criteria as per documents enclosed in Annexure I.
- Eligible bidder shall be considered for technical scoring and subsequent opening of Financial Bid.
- A bidder with a Minimum Technical score of 60% based on the technical criteria will qualify for opening of financial bid. The financial bid shall be opened who have qualified in technical parameters.
- For evaluation of the bid, 70% weightage shall be given to the score achieved on Technical Bid and 30% weightage shall be given to the score achieved on Financial Bid.
- The lowest Price Bid would be assigned the score of 100 and the other bidders would be assigned the score based on the respective sequence in descending order.
