- (d) Bid evaluation is to be carried out strictly in accordance to Gujarat State Procurement Policy 2024 and its amendments.
- (e) The Authority reserves the absolute right / discretion to accept and/or reject any of the bids received; or invite fresh bids, at any stage of the tendering process.
- (f) The bid of the bidder shall be evaluated to ascertain compliance of the bidder with the eligibility conditions and requirements of the Tender. Only those bidders who are found to be eligible in accordance with the prescribed eligibility conditions shall be declared as “eligible bidders”.
- (g) The Bidders are required to quote the rates strictly in accordance with the terms and conditions of the Tender document. Conditional bids shall not be entertained and will be liable for outright rejection.
- (h) Material misrepresentation in the bid by any bidder means intentionally hiding or fabricating important information, and if such information comes to the Authority's knowledge, it could have terminated or significantly alter the basis of the transaction.
- (i) Submission of false or incorrect information, reports of unprofessional conduct, amongst other things, shall lead to disqualification of the bidder.
- (j) The bidder shall submit a declaration stating that is unconditionally and irrevocably accepting all the terms and conditions of the Tender.
- (k) To assist in the scrutiny, evaluation and comparison of bids, the Authority may, at its discretion, seek from any or all bidders, clarification(s) or its/their bids, including technical information, documents and materials after the opening of the technical bid, but before the opening of the price bids.
- (l) Even if a bidder meets the eligibility or qualification criteria, it shall be subject to disqualification if it or any of its constituting elements / partners / entities is found to have:
  - 1) Made misleading or false representations in the forms, statements, affidavits and attachments submitted in proof of the qualification requirements.
  - 2) Proposal not submitted in accordance with this tender.
  - 3) During validity of the proposal, or its extended period, if any, the bidder changes his commercial terms.
  - 4) The tender documents received are not duly signed by authorized person.

- 5) The validity of tender is less than what is stated in the tender.
- (m) The bidder shall submit a declaration that the bidder or any of its constituting entities /persons/members have not been blacklisted or debarred (called by any name whatsoever) by the Central Government or any State Government; or any undertaking of the Central Government or State Governments in the preceding 3 (three) years from the date of submission of the bid. If, at any time, such declaration is found to be false, it shall amount to submission of misleading information and will entitle the Authority to reject the bid or forthwith cancel a contract / work already awarded.
- (n) All terms and conditions of GEM shall form an integral part of this Tender; and shall be required to be complied with by the bidder. In the event of conflict between the terms and conditions of GEM; and these Additional Terms and Conditions, these Additional Terms and Conditions shall prevail to the limited extent of the conflict.
- (o) The currency of bid and payment shall be in Indian Rupees. All payments shall be made in Indian Rupees.
- (p) Bidders shall submit offers that comply with the requirements of the Tender. Alternatives will not be considered, unless specifically called for by the Authority.
- (q) Bid shall not be modified by the bidder after the deadline for submission of bids.
- (r) To assist in the examination, evaluation, and comparison of Bids, the Authority may, at its discretion, ask any Bidder for clarification of his Bid. The request for clarification and the response shall be only via mail or online bid portal, but no change in the price or substance of the Bid shall be sought, nor shall it be offered.
- (s) A responsive Bid is the one which conforms to all the terms, conditions and specification of the Bidding documents including time for completion, without material deviation or reservation. A material deviation or reservation is the one which
- a. Affects in any substantial way the scope, quality or performance of the Works;
  - b. Which limits in any substantial way, the Authority's rights or the Bidder's obligations under the Contract, or
  - c. Whose rectification would affect unfairly the competitive position of other Bidders presenting responsive Bids.

### **3. Service Provider's Obligation**

- (a) The successful bidder shall not assign or subcontract any portion of the work under this tender.
- (b) Bidders shall not have any dispute or claim for any compensation if the quantity stipulated in the tender items varies or the scope of work changes and thereby the total amount of work increases or decreases, or if the work gets delayed or postponed for any reason whatsoever.
- (c) From commencement to completion of the work/contract as a whole, the product/service provider shall take full responsibility for the care thereof and for taking precautions to prevent loss or damage. He shall be liable for any damage or loss that may happen to the works or any part thereof.

- (e) The service provider shall have full regard, throughout execution, completion, and defects liability period, to following safety aspects and shall take all necessary steps to ensure that danger to safety is avoided all the time in respect of the safety of the works, the safety of the service provider's employees, and all the persons directly or indirectly engaged by him for the works.
- (f) The service provider and its employee have to strictly follow the instructions governed by authority related to safety.
- (g) The service provider has to be obliged to reimburse the losses caused directly or indirectly to the property or to any equipment, material, or service, including wires, pipelines, government records, or the belongings of officers or employees, or any loss due to the service provider's incompetence, negligence, willfulness, or for any other reason.

  - iii. Breach of SLAs: The contract may also be terminated if the cumulative deductions rise to 10% of the contract value

However, termination of this Contract shall not affect any accrued rights or remedies of either party.
